1. Policy Statement

Teaching and Coaching Staff

Carry out dynamic risk assessments before and during all sessions or off-site activities.

Ensure pupils use equipment safely and responsibly.

Report any hazards, damage, or concerns to leadership immediately.

Follow all Academy policies on first aid, emergency procedures, and supervision.

4. Pupil and Visitor Safety

Pupils are encouraged to behave safely and responsibly.

Visitors must sign in, follow safety instructions, and be accompanied if required.

All safeguarding policies must be followed alongside this policy.

5. Emergencies and First Aid

A trained first aider is available on site at all times.

All staff are aware of fire exits, evacuation points, and lockdown procedures.

Accidents are recorded and reviewed to reduce risk of recurrence.

6. Monitoring and Review

This policy is reviewed annually or following any significant incident or change in legislation. Risk assessments and health and safety audits are carried out termly.
